SPECIALS CURRICULUM

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The elementary art program seeks to meet the needs of every student while encouraging playful inquiry of materials, ideas, and expression. Students learn that creative thinking and learning not only enable problem-solving skills while creating artwork but also in real life. Teachers encourage students to express and explore thoughts and ideas using their God-given abilities. The art teachers adhere to a Biblical Worldview Philosophy while teaching curriculum, which meets state standards and benchmarks. Areas of study include drawing, painting, design, ceramics, sculpture, and fiber art. Students meet two periods per week.

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This course introduces students to the instruments offered in the band program. Each student chooses an instrument of interest and receives instruction for that instrument as each develops his or her God-given abilities. Beginners can choose from the flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, trombone, baritone, or percussion. Fifth graders perform at least twice during the school year. This band is not an elective but a class taken by all fifth graders. Educators present all material from a Biblical Worldview.
