New normal is one of the current catch phrases we are hearing all the time. I don't know if this is the new normal, but I do know that to continue educating God's children, we may have to make some adjustments to how we do things until this season passes.

Some of you will think our plans are too much, some of you will think it's not enough. And some of you will think they're just right! As a Christian school, we do not always have the same requirements that our Public School counterparts do; however, we are required to follow health

department standards. It is our desire to provide our children with a biblically based education while in a physically and emotionally safe environment!

Moving into the fall, we have researched and prepared 4 different plans to address a wide variety of possibilities, taking into account current government mandates and expectations for schools and using the Michigan Safe Start <u>Plan</u> as a framework. Recommendations have been reviewed from the CDC, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration, the Missouri Department of Education's plan and the Macomb County Health Department, to create 4 plans for what measures may be in place for the safety of our school children.

Our intention is to have on site learning in the fall! We do not intend to have a hybrid of part online and part face to fa

Plan Level 1, No Students Onsite:

- This is currently a low probability
- Summer planning will analyze our 4th quarter distance learning process
 New plan will be developed based on parent, teacher, student and administration input to address the learning needs of our students during any

Plan Level 2, On Site With Strict Social Distancing:

- On-site learning
- Building access limited
- All students and staff will have a temperature check in the morning
- All face to face learning
- 6 feet apart social distancing
- Obviously, this will require fewer students in each classroom to ensure we are 6 feet apart. Some things to note:
 - All of our available space has been measured

- We have determined we have enough space if we use all rooms as classrooms, including some on the church side of the building
- With fewer students in each classroom, we will have a need for more staff
- Room and staff needs will be determined by our enrollment
- To reduce hallway interaction, all students preschool-8, will stay in assigned classrooms
- Teachers will move from room to room as assigned
- We will continue to Cultivate Gifts by having special classes continue, although they will be reduced.
- We remain committed to Biblical training and will create plans for chapel teaching and worship to continue in a way that is safe for our community.
- If all schools are shut down for an increase in Covid cases, we will transition to online education with no break in learning. If your family needs a device for your child, we have additional ipads you are able to use.
- We plan to increase the number and availability of our social emotional support staff
- We plan to increase our resource room staff to accommodate an increase in student support needs
- CDC guidelines for sanitization of the rooms will be adopted
- Increase hand sanitizing stations in the building
- Lunch will be in the classrooms allowing for use of the cafeteria space for classrooms
- Recess will be class by class and will include the playground
 - If you prefer your child not play on the playground we will have two options for the students. One will be a movie in the auditorium with appropriate social distancing and we will also create a walking or skipping club around the ring road when possible

Plan Level 3, On Site With Social Distancing:

- All face to face learning
- Students preschool-8 will be in assigned classrooms
- Teachers will move to classrooms
- Increase special classes as able
- If all schools are shut down for an increase in Covid cases, we will transition to online education with no break in learning. If your family needs a device for your child, we have additional ipads you are able to use.
- We plan to increase the number and availability of our social emotional support staff
- We plan to increase our resource room staff to accommodate an increase in student support needs
- Access to the building will be by pre-arranged appointments only
- CDC guidelines for sanitization of the rooms will be adopted
- Increase hand sanitizing stations in the building

Plan Level 4. The "Old Normal":

- CDC guidelines for sanitization of the rooms will be adopted
- Increase hand sanitizing stations in the building
- We plan to increase the number and availability of our social emotional support staff
 - We recognize that developmentally our children have gone through a trauma event on a global scale and we will be working to support them in a variety of ways.
- We plan to increase our resource room staff to accommodate an increase in student support needs

For those of you desiring to have a homeschool continuation, we are working on being able to provide 2 options for you to consider. There will be further information as we move into summer.

After going through all that, please note our number one priority will be caring for and nurturing your children. To do that, we will do all we can to keep them safe.

We are planning a zoom meeting to address any questions and concerns at 7pm on Monday, June 8, 2020. Please complete your google form with any questions you have by 4pm on Friday, June 5, 2020.

God is still in control, and none of this is a surprise to him. This is a lot of information to digest, and many of you will likely have questions. We will be sending this information in written form as well and will include a form for your questions. Then I will host a zoom meeting to address those questions to the best of my ability. In addition, we will be sending out a survey to give you the opportunity to help us plan for next year. Please complete this survey as we want your input to best be able to serve our community. Also, we want to encourage you to apply for assistance if you are concerned about tuition payments. We will do our best to help those in need.

Please know, these plans have been thoughtfully researched and prayerfully considered. I cannot wait to see your children again face to face, to teach them in chapel, to encourage them to look to the Lord for all of their needs. I will do whatever it takes to continue to provide a balanced, Christ-centered education for all of our students, in whichever phase or level we find ourselves in.
