## Elementary Learning

Elementary parents, all learning packets and materials for students in PreK3-5th grade are ready to be picked up. Our teachers have been dedicated in putting together resources to make this transition over to remote learning a smooth one. ## Pick-up Procedures

The building will be open on Tuesday, March 17th, from 7am - 7pm for families to retrieve items they need, such as learning materials from the classrooms, medications, items from lockers, etc. In alignment with the most recent recommendations from the CDC, it is our goal to limit social interactions during this pickup window. Please review and comply with the following procedures:

- Enter the circle drive
- If there are other vehicles in the circle drive
  - Please wait in your vehicle until advised to enter the building
- If there are no other vehicles in the circle drive
  - Please enter the building
- Only one adult per family should enter the building
  - If you are a single adult with children in the car, notify a staff member and your items will be collected and brought to you at your vehicle
- Once in the building, please go directly to the appropriate classroom(s) to collect the work/packet/items needed
- Immediately return to your vehicle upon retrieving all items
- Avoid social interactions/congregating in any area of the building at any time, including interactions with staff

We understand that this goes against our normal human behavior and we greatly appreciate your understanding and willingness to do your part to keep everyone in our community safe.

### Zoom Video Conferencing

As mentioned in a previous communication, our staff will be instituting the use of Zoom for video conferencing calls with our students. First, it is not required that a student join the Zoom call. It is there as a resource and to allow for interaction between the students and with the teacher. Second, there will be set times for the class to connect with a teacher and ask any questions they may have. Those times will be communicated to you in the next day or so, if they have not been communicated already. Finally, please note that we have asked that all staff record their Zoom meetings as a record of interaction and for their safety. Any recorded Zoom conversations may be posted to Google Classroom (MS/HS), if there is helpful information to those who were unable to join the call.

Please note, Zoom is a communication website/app which will require age appropriate parental monitoring.
