- Would Graduation Option C include Siblings?
 - If we were limited to a group of 150 or less, we may not be able to include siblings
- o How do we get things that we left at the school?
 - Once the restrictions have been loosened, we will have a schedule for when people will be able to come to the school building and pick up items.
 We anticipate this will be sometime in mid to late June
- What if we already have a vacation scheduled for the last weekend of July (Senior week)?
 - We would not recommend changing any plans in case the restrictions are not lifted prior to July 28th. We are limited to availability of the venues we will be using for our events (Mac & Rae's, BCC, etc.) This would be a personal family choice once the time is closer.
- Will there be a senior all-night party?
 - This is a parent sponsored event and Mrs. Pannecouk answered that once LifeTime is open, she will contact and see what the availability would be for the event.
- When will diplomas be distributed?
 - Diplomas will be distributed at graduation
- o Any news about Sound of Music?
 - Still listed as postponed. No date has been selected yet. Waiting until restrictions are lifted or lessened
- Will Graduation and Prom be included in the Yearbook?
 - Yes, we have contacted Josten's and they have allowed us to push our deadline to early August. This will also delay when we will receive the yearbooks to September/October.
