


Elementary Dress Code

Students are expected to be well groomed, neatly dressed, and follow age and gender appropriate dress and grooming habits. The following standards are not intended to be all encompassing. Administrators have the responsibility and authority to apply these general guidelines when confronted with questionable appearance not covered specifically.

Program

Daily Uniform: every day uniforms

Spiritwear: optional (not part of daily uniform, only to be worn on casual days)

Gym Uniforms: Grades 5-12 only

Non-logo items may be purchased at any local store, i.e., Target, Old Navy, Kohls, etc.

General Dress - Daily Uniform

Uniforms are described below:

- All clothing must be plain, logos other than specified are not permitted.
- All students should be in dress code upon arrival at school and after 3:00 pm until they leave the building or until they are in the gym area.
- Hair should be neat. No extreme shaved portions of the head (designs, dyed or cut in). The hair must be groomed. Colors may not deviate from the spectrum of natural color.
- Skirts (for girls) and shorts (girls and boys) must fall in the middle of below fingertip length and the top of the knee, including ALL items worn with tights/leggings.

- Boys are not permitted to wear earrings at school or at any school events.
- Only ear piercings are allowed for girls. No other visible piercings are allowed.
- Field trip dress will be dictated by the activity. Students will be informed of what is acceptable dress prior to the trip.
- No headwear (such as hats, visors, bandanas, sunglasses, etc.) may be worn or carried in the building during the day. When a student arrives at school, all headwear should be placed promptly in the student's locker.
- Outer coats must be put in the locker upon arriving at school and are not permitted in the classroom. Uniform sweaters are permitted at any time.
- Sagging and low-rise pants are not acceptable, underwear should not be visible.
- Any display of cleavage is considered inappropriate.
- Administration reserves the right to address any concerns regarding dress code compliance.

Casual Dress

Casual dress day options include:

- All-School casual
- Casual for \$1.00
- Pre-Paid Casual
- PCS spirit casual
- Special Casuals

All opportunities for casual dress will be fulfilled on the assigned days for that privilege. If a student is absent or for some other reason misses the assigned day, the privilege is forfeited. Exceptions are granted through the administration only. Approval must be granted before any make-up days are awarded.

Casual Day Dress Restrictions

- Shirts may be worn untucked, however, if the midriff is exposed when the arms are lifted, the shirt must be changed.
- No tank tops.
- Mesh and see-through tops are inappropriate.
- No political, vulgar, obscene, disrespectful, or suggestive words, pictures, or graphics should be worn on any clothing or accessories.
- Skirts and shorts must fall in the middle of below fingertip length and the top of the knee, including ALL items worn with tights/leggings.
- No pants with holes, patches, or threads above the knees.
- No spandex, leggings, yoga pants or other pants/shorts that accentuates any part of the anatomy for boys or girls is unacceptable apparel.
- No tight fitting or cleavage revealing attire.
- No slippers or flip flops.
- For PCS Spirit casual, students must be in PCS logo clothing after the 1st quarter. Prior to the first quarter, students may wear red, white and blue.
- The basic rule to follow is, "If in doubt, do not wear it".

Violations of the Dress Code

- The administration reserves the right to declare any inappropriate dress as violation of the dress code, and parents will be notified.

Daily Uniform - Kindergarten Boys & Girls

Tops

- Short Sleeve Everyday Tee: Navy, Royal or Red—Logo REQUIRED
 - Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Crew Sweatshirt: Navy, Royal or Red—Logo REQUIRED
 - Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>

Bottoms

- Pull on Pant: Khaki or Navy
- Bermuda Short: Khaki or Navy
- Co-Ed Sweatpant: Navy, Royal, Red or Gray— logo is not required

Accessories

- Socks: any color, crew length or longer is the expectation with skirts, any length with pants.
- Shoes: Tennis or Athletic Style Shoe. Must be rubber soled.
 - The following are not permitted: Moccasins, Crocs, Flip Flops, Sandals, Slides, Boots, Wheelies/Heelies, etc)

Girls – Elementary School grades 1-4

Tops

- Long Sleeve Oxford Button Down: White or Powder Blue—Logo REQUIRED—Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Polo: Red or Navy (May have logo added if purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.)
- Turtleneck: Red or Navy
- Cardigan: Navy or Medium Gray Heather, plain weave (May have logo added if purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.)
- Crew Sweatshirt: Navy, Royal, Red or Gray— Logo REQUIRED—Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Navy Blazer optional, must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Plaid jumper: tent or center pleat with slit (length to the bend of the knee)
 - Please note, plaid will be finalized for 2023/24 school year.
- Jumpers must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger. (plaid will be determined for the 23/24 school year)

Bottoms

- Ponte Skort: Khaki or Navy—Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Pants: Khaki or Navy cotton twill fabric, straight leg or bootcut, flat front, (**no skinny, low rise or cargo pocket type**)
 - 1st Grade only has the option to purchase pull on pants
- Bermuda shorts: Khaki or Navy cotton twill fabric, straight leg, flat front, (**no skinny, low rise or cargo pocket type**)
 - 1st Grade only has the option to purchase pull on bermuda shorts

Accessories

- Belt: black or dark brown—plain leather or leather-like (optional)
- Leggings/Layering Shorts: Black, only permitted under jumper
- Socks: any color, crew length or longer is the expectation with skirts, any length with pants.
- Shoes: The following are not permitted: Moccasins, Crocs, Flip Flops, Sandals, Slides, Boots, Wheelies/Heelies, etc)

Boys – Elementary School grades 1-4

Tops

- Polo: Red or Navy (May have logo added if purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.)
- Long Sleeve Oxford Button Down: White or Powder Blue—Logo REQUIRED—Must be purchased from Tommy Hilfiger School Uniforms at <https://www.globalschoolwear.com/>
- Turtleneck: Red or Navy
- Full Zip Sweater: Navy or Medium Gray Heather, plain weave (May have logo added if purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.)
- Sweater Vest: Navy or Medium Gray Heather, plain weave (May have logo added if purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.)
- Crew Sweatshirt: Navy, Royal, Red or Gray— Logo REQUIRED

- Navy Blazer (optional)
