Congratulations on the completion of another school year! The following is the 7th-grade summer reading requirement for the summer of 2023. The purpose of summer reading is to enjoy literature as well as prevent students' reading and writing skills from regressing. 7th-grade students are required to read and complete an assignment on the following book:

Walking with Miss Millie by Tamara Bundy

Assignment Part 1- Paragraph Writing

Your paragraphs will show your teacher how well you can write, so please do your best. Make sure to address all bullet points. Paragraphs should have a minimum of 7-8 sentences.

On a separate sheet of paper, write two well-developed paragraphs on the main character from the novel *Walking with Miss Millie*

Paragraph 1:

• Give a description of your character (tell what he/she looks like, hobbies, abilities, strengths, weaknesses, ect.)

Paragraph 2:

- Trace the development of your character throughout the novel:
 - What is he/she like at the beginning of the novel?
 - How does he/she change as the novel progresses?
 - How is he/she different at the end of the novel than he/she was at the beginning?
 - Explain the change and what caused it by giving examples from the novel

Assignment Part 2- Character Head Characterization Project

Choose one main character and characterize him or her using the template provided.

The template must contain the following:

- □ Character's name in a large font.
- \Box Two significant character quotes.
- \square Two images relevant to the character (concrete or abstract).
- \Box Three adjectives to describe the character.
- \Box The character's nickname in the story, or one you create.
- □ The title of the novel or story, author, and genre.
- \Box Use an attractive color scheme with virtually no white space.
- All text is legible, dark, and attractive. Final text is not written in pencil.
- □ Head is securely glued to reinforced backing. (construction paper, cardstock, or poster)
- $\hfill\square$ Head and backing are cut and trimmed neatly.
- $\hfill\square$ Error free in grammar, mechanics, and spelling.
- $\hfill\square$ Name and grade on the back of the final project.
- □ Attention to detail, high quality of work.
- $\hfill\square$ Quality of work reflects knowledge and understanding of character.
